

# Knitting

## Getting Started

- Position the knitting machine so you are looking at the red feeder and the counter.
- Rotate the crank until the furthest right black hook is up and aligned with the feeder.
- Flip the red switch on the side to choose **Plain Knitting** (flat) or **Circular Knitting**.
- Press the reset button on the counter if you would like to keep track of the stitch count.
- Hook the thread in the first raised black hook then rotate the crank and hook the thread on every other hook
- Stop when you come back to the first black hook.
- Plain knit: the crank will stop and you can move the crank in the opposite direction to continue.
- Circular knit: Continue cranking until done.
- When you reach your desired length stop cranking.
- Note be sure to leave 3 feet of thread or more at the tail end of the project for finishing.
- Use the plastic needle to catch each loop on the ring and pull it off the ring.
- Tie a knot in the last loop.
